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MPU 2022 LED Light Bulb Incentive

and last up to 25 years.

MPU Residential LED Light Bulb Rebate Application: January 1 – December 31, 2022

MPU is providing the LED Light Bulb Rebate Program to help you save energy, lower your utility bill, and protect the environment. LED light bulbs are energy efficient. A 9-watt LED bulb replaces a 60-watt incandescent bulb and can last up to 25 years before needing replacement. Saving energy benefits everyone!

Details:

1. LED Light Bulb Rebate Program is only available to RESIDENTIAL electric customers of MPU.
2. Only LED light bulbs used for general lighting purposes (40-100 watt equivalent) are eligible for this rebate. Decorative and holiday lights are not eligible.
3. Rebate amount is limited to a maximum of \$20 per customer household. There is no limit on the number of bulbs or the cost of bulbs.
4. Rebate will appear as a credit on your utility bill.
5. Rebate excludes sales tax.

* MPU has final approval of all applications and reserves the right to terminate the Residential Customer LED Light Bulb Rebate Program at its sole discretion and without advanced notice.
