

OTHER RESOURCES AVAILABLE

- The Keep Wisconsin Warm Fund (KWWF) responds to the need of Wisconsin's elderly, disabled and families with young children with critical energy needs throughout Wisconsin. Go to www.kwwf.org or call 1-800-891-WARM.
- Check with your utility company to see if you are eligible for other energy conservation measures they may provide.

Emergency Furnace/Boiler Program:

The Home Energy Plus Furnace Program can provide heating system repair or replacement to eligible homeowners if the heating system stops operating or is unsafe to use. Call your local Energy Assistance office immediately if you are experiencing a no heat or unsafe situation.

Partners Home Rehabilitation and Accessibility Program (HRA)

If you are a homeowner who resides in a single family home in need of further critical repairs in Manitowoc, Sheboygan, Door, or Kewaunee Counties, Partners HRA program may be able to assist you. This program focuses on home repairs that are unable to be addressed by the weatherization program such as roof repair, window replacement, and plumbing and electrical repairs. The HRA program is a 0% interest loan that is secured through property liens which are paid back when the home is sold or is no longer the homeowner's primary address. ELIGIBILITY

You must apply for the Wisconsin Home Energy Assistance Program (WHEAP) in order to become income qualified for the State of Wisconsin, Weatherization Assistance Program.

To qualify for Energy Assistance, proof of all income sources for the entire household's gross income for the past 3 months must be submitted, in addition to other non-financial requirements.

SERVICES AVAILABLE

The State of Wisconsin, Weatherization Assistance Program can help homeowners and renters reduce energy consumption while increasing the comfort in their homes. These energy efficient improvements may also make your home environment healthier and safer.

Energy efficient improvements provided through the Weatherization program differ with each home depending on various factors. Contingent on the home's eligibility; a thorough evaluation of your home may be performed by one of our Certified Energy Auditors to determine what can be done to improve the energy efficiency and comfort.

Eligibility for Weatherization services is not limited to homeowners. If you are a renter and live in a single family home, duplex, or apartment building, you may also be eligible.

WEATHERIZATION MAY INCLUDE:

- Insulate attic, walls and floors
- Replace water heater
- Install energy efficient lighting
- Reduce air leakage
- Repair or replace heating system
- Replace refrigerator and/or deep freezer
- A health and safety inspection
- Information about maintenance and energy conservation

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Any household that has been approved for Energy Assistance at their current address within the past year is eligible to apply for services through the Weatherization Program, regardless of whether the dwelling is rented or owner occupied.

Occupants of an eligible property or their landlords (for rental properties) may apply for Weatherization. An application must be submitted by the home's occupant. For rental properties, a separate landlord questionnaire must also be submitted.

After the required paperwork has been submitted and eligibility has been determined, an evaluation of the dwelling may be performed to assess what energy-saving measures are needed to improve your home's energy efficiency and comfort.
