**RESOLUTION OF MANITOWOC PUBLIC UTILITIES COMISSION  
RECOGNIZING PUBLIC POWER WEEK, OCTOBER 4-10, 2020**

WHEREAS, we, the citizens of Manitowoc, place high value on local control over community services and therefore have chosen to operate a community-owned, locally controlled, not-for-profit electric utility and, as consumers and owners of our electric utility, have a direct say in utility operations and policies; and

WHEREAS, MPU provides our homes, businesses, farms, social service, and local government agencies with safe, reliable, efficient, and cost-effective electricity employing sound business practices designed to ensure the best possible service at not-for-profit rates; and


WHEREAS, MPU is a valuable community asset that contributes substantially to the well-being of local citizens through energy efficiency, customer service, environmental protection, economic development, and safety awareness;

NOW THEREFORE, the Commission resolves as follows:

1. That MPU will continue to work to bring lower-cost, safe, reliable electricity (and water services) to community homes and businesses just as it has since the utility was created; and
2. That the week of October 4-10 be designated Public Power Week in order to honor MPU for its contributions to the community and to make its consumer-owners, policy makers, and employees more aware of its contributions to their well-being; and
3. That our community joins hands with more than 2,000 other public power systems in the United States in this celebration of PUBLIC POWER.
