

MANITOWOC PUBLIC UTILITIES NEW LOAD MARKET PRICING TARIFF

The New Load Market Pricing Tariff (NLMP) is designed to provide new and existing customers access to Wholesale Energy Rates (NLMP Rates) for new load and load expansion of greater than 400 kW. Although results vary by month and savings are not assured, NLMP Rates tend to be lower than standard utility tariff rates by as much as 20%.

- The new load or load growth must be greater than 400 kW and be maintained for eight out of twelve months in each contract year.
- A Customer must affirmatively declare that this NLMP Tariff was a factor in its decision to expand load with the Utility.
- NLMP Tariff is not available to customers transferring existing load from any other electric utility provider in Wisconsin.
- NLMP Tariff is for a single term of four (4) consecutive years after which time the customer will be moved to the appropriate utility tariff.
- A Customer may terminate service on the annual anniversary date of the NLMP Tariff service with a 30 day written notice. Upon termination, the customer will be placed on the applicable utility tariff.
