ELIGIBILITY

You **MUST** apply for the Wisconsin Home Energy Assistance Program (WHEAP) in order to qualify for Weatherization services.

To qualify for Energy Assistance, proof of all income sources for the entire household's gross income for the previous 1 month must be submitted, in addition to other non-financial requirements.

SERVICES AVAILABLE

The State of Wisconsin Weatherization Assistance Program can help reduce your utility bills, conserve energy and make your home warmer in the winter and cooler in the summer.

Weatherization services differ with each home depending on how it was built and its condition.

Eligibility for Weatherization services is not limited to homeowners.

Weatherization measures may include replacement of:

- Lightbulbs
- Refrigerator
- Freezer
- Water heater

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Energy Assistance at their current address within the past year is eligible to apply for services through the Weatherization Program, regardless of whether the dwelling is rented or owner occupied.

Occupants of an eligible property or their landlords (for rental properties) may apply for Weatherization. An application must be submitted by the home's occupant. For rental properties, a separate landlord questionnaire must be submitted.

After the required paperwork has been submitted and eligibility has been determined, an evaluation of the dwelling may be performed to assess what energy-saving measures are needed to improve your home's energy efficiency and comfort.
